Foundation Award in Theology, Ministry and Mission (60 credits)

- 1. This programme is available at Lindisfarne College of Theology in part-time mode of study.
- 2. This programme requires the completion of 60 credits at Level 4.
- 3. All biblical language modules and ILP modules are delivered on-line.
- 4. The TMM1437/TMM1417 Chaplaincy Placement set-up and closure tutorials may be delivered through a blend of in-person and on-line tutorials.
- 5. All other modules are delivered in-person.
- 6. Students will negotiate their choice of modules with the Director of Studies according to module availability in any year of study.
