T3: Programme Regulations 2023–24

Master of Arts in Theology, Ministry and Mission (180 credits)

- 1. This programme of study is available at the Scottish Episcopal Institute in a part-time (over 2, 3 or 4 years) mode of study.
- 2. Candidates shall study and be assessed to a maximum of 180 credits and a minimum of 150 credits at Level 7; a maximum of 30 credits may be studied and assessed at Levels 4, 5 and 6.
- 3. Candidates shall negotiate their choice of modules with the Director of studies in light of the ministry for which there are preparing or in which they already serve and according to module availability in any year of study.
