Demonstrate a systematic understanding and depth of knowledge of areas of study or of professional practice in theology, ministry and mission that is informed by research and original thinking at current boundaries of the field.

Understand, assimilate and evaluate critically methodologies and findings of advanced scholarship and research in the chosen area(s) of theology, ministry and mission.

Demonstrate an understanding of a range of methods of analysis and enquiry in theology, ministry and mission.

Give a critical and comprehensive account of a range of methods for relating their chosen field of study to aspects of faith, church and society.

Apply their knowledge and professional competence so as to reach valid conclusions when confronted by new problems and situations, and report these findings effectively within the conventions of the relevant academic or professional community.

Make professional or academic judgments which may involve others and which recognise the limits of their own competence.

Reflect theologically in a sophisticated and rigorous manner, exercising sound judgement when engaging systematically and creatively with complex, unpredictable and ambiguous realities in the church and the world today.

Communicate complex information and detailed argument with clarity, sensitivity, fairness and imagination to specialist and non-specialist audiences.

Demonstrate initiative, self-direction and independence in tackling and solving problems, and in planning and implementing tasks.

Exercise their independent learning skills to pursue further professional development or academic study.
