

Graduate Certificate in Theology, Ministry and Mission (60 Credits)

1. This programme is available at **St Augustine's College of Theology** in part-time and full-time modes of study. Students can either attend all teaching in person or use a blend of in-person and online teaching (though some modules may only be available in either online or in-person format).

Some students will follow pathways designed to meet the expectations of their sponsoring Churches; others study independently. Current pathways are designated as Initial Ministerial Education (Ordained Ministry), subdivided in Phase 1 (OM1) and Phase 2 (OM2); and Independent Students (IS). Information about pathways is primarily included for the benefit of the representative from the Churches' Quality in Formation Panel, though it will of course also be of interest to others. Indicative pathways are shown in the supplementary document, 'Indicative Pathways for Quality in Formation Panel'.

2. The tables below refer to the various delivery modes available as follows: (A) in-person delivery only; (B) online delivery only; (C) a combination of in-person and online delivery.
3. Candidates may study and be assessed in level 4 or 5 modules up to the value of 20 credits.
