GENERAL; As the fuller tables (also circulated) will show, in all cases the CDP areas showed lower rates of economic activity, and higher rates of unemployment and sickness, than their respective parent local authorities (all measured here on present boundaries); the 1991 data show a male unemployment rate in Benwell of 39.9%; other types of ONS data show a reduction unemployment since 2011
